Possible Good News About Drive Clean!

The Ontario Government is proposing changes to the Drive Clean Program that, if implemented, will be the news many UCDA members have been waiting to hear for years!

The Government is proposing to eliminate the requirement to perform a Drive Clean test on the sale of light duty vehicles (LDVs).

The proposal does not go as far as eliminating Drive Clean entirely. The requirement to test vehicles would still apply to vehicles, 7 years model years and older, **but only when renewing the vehicle's licence plate.**

The UCDA supports this Proposal, as it would eliminate the need for Members to test vehicles prior to selling them, regardless of the vehicle's age.
