THE END OF DRIVE CLEAN ON USED VEHICLE SALES

As we reported in September, after years of lobbying the Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change, it seems the Ministry has listened.

Starting April 1st, 2017 vehicles weighing less than 4,500 kilograms (i.e. light duty and passenger vehicles) will no longer need to pass a Drive Clean test before being sold!

Drive Clean tests will continue to be required for licence plate **renewals** on vehicles 7 model years old and older, but the needless expense and hassle involved in testing light duty vehicles in order to **sell** them to consumers will be gone!
